

Ecological Protection Commitment

I. Purpose and Commitment

II. Scope of Application

This ecological protection commitment (the "Commitment") applies to Wison Engineering and its applicable branches, subsidiaries, and relevant entities under the Company's operational and management control. 3. Avoid impacting the ecological environment with best effort and will restore the ecology of the affected areas after project completion, such as through vegetation restoration, land leveling, and ecological compensation.

4. Respect the interests of all stakeholders, jointly promote biodiversity conservation efforts, and disclose relevant information in a timely manner.
5. Support the protection of forest resources, commit to complying with laws and regulations related to biodiversity and forest protection, and strive to avoid adverse impacts from our business activities.
