

Supplementary Disclosure on Waste Recycling and Disposal Methods

The supplementary disclosure on waste recycling and disposal methods (the "Supplementary Disclosure") is a thematic supplement to the respective annual environmental, social and governance reports (the "ESG Reports") of Wison Engineering Services Co. Ltd. ("Wison Engineering" or "the Company"), focusing on the recycling, reuse, and final disposal pathways for waste from 2022 to 2025. The Supplementary Disclosure does not supersede the relevant content of the annual ESG Reports, and readers should read them in conjunction.

Data Scope and Management Approach

The Supplementary Disclosure adopts the reporting boundaries of the respective annual ESG Reports. Unless otherwise specified, the data in the tables primarily reflects waste generated by the Company itself at its office premises and relevant project sites, and does not include waste generated by tenants and subcontractors. As the project portfolio and construction stages may vary from year to year, the annual data should not be interpreted on a standalone basis as year-on-year changes in management performance.

In accordance with the internal requirements for waste and hazardous materials management, the Company implements applicable source reduction, segregated collection, temporary storage, transfer, recovery, and disposal of waste. Wison Engineering continuously improves data quality and management performance through record reviews, contractor communication, and issue rectification.

- "0.00" indicates that the amount for the year was confirmed to be zero; "Not disaggregated" indicates that the total amount is available, but historical data was not categorized by specific disposal pathway; "Not separately disclosed" indicates that the indicator was not listed separately in historical public disclosures; "Disposal method unknown" indicates that the amount is available, but existing records are insufficient to reliably confirm the final disposal pathway.
- Detailed disposal pathway information is unavailable for 2022 and 2023, and the Company has not made retrospective estimates or subjective allocations for historical data.
- The total waste amount disclosed in the annual ESG Reports comprises the recycled/reused amount, the amount of food and domestic waste disposed, construction waste generated, and the amount of hazardous waste disposed. The total amounts from 2022 to 2025 were 7,544.68, 11,867.85, 3,825.99, and 2,071.51 metric tons, respectively.
- Waste management is integrated with the Company's environmental management, resource efficiency, pollution prevention, project site management, contractor management, and environmental compliance.
